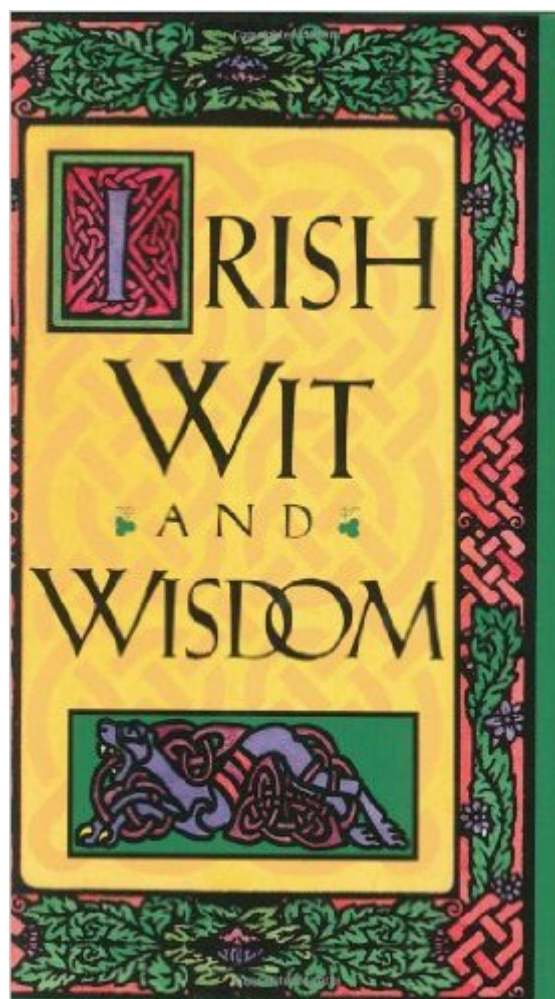

colorful and have a place to enscribe the name of the person you are giving it to. If you have become frustrated with the ridiculously priced greeting cards; why not choose a small book like this. Anyone receiving it will be impressed. At only \$4.95, it's about the price of a card. The book has an introduction and the sections are broken down into: Blarney Folklore Fairies--Fair and Fowl Irish Humor Proverbs and Sayings Limericks and Toasts. Not only is this book enjoyable, but it is also informative. I really like the section on Fairies. Here you will learn all about Fairies, and yes Leprechauns too. Did you know there were Pooka, Gheancanach and Clobher-ceann as well? As Queen Elizabeth who is credited with first using the word blarney, once said "Blarney, Blarney--it's all Blarney. What he says he does not mean. What he means he does not say."
