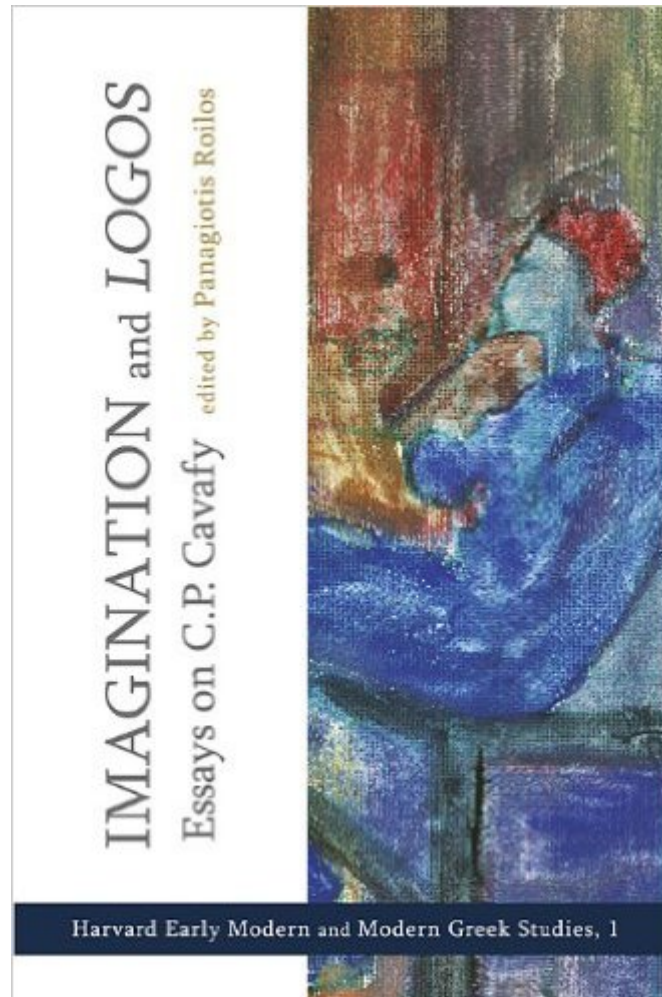


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Imagination And Logos: Essays On C. P. Cavafy (Cultural Politics, Socioaesthetics, Beginnings)



Synopsis

This book explores diverse but complementary interdisciplinary approaches to the poetics, intertexts, and influence of the work of C. P. Cavafy (Konstantinos Kavafis), one of the most important twentieth-century European poets.
