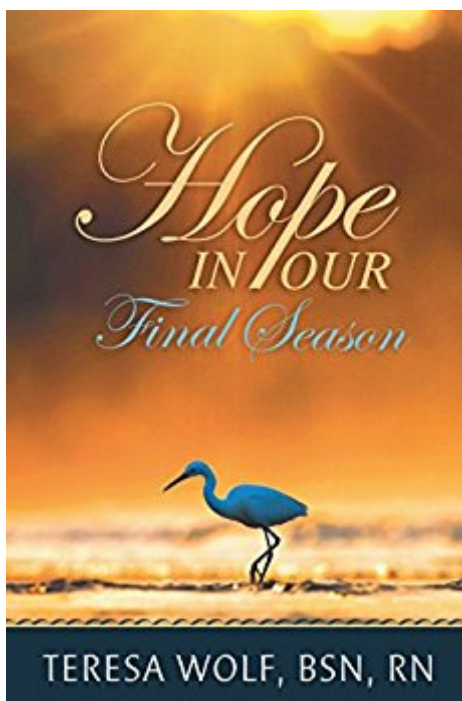

The resources for affordable facilities for end-of-life care in our communities are scarce or nonexistent. The millions of seniors across the country who need an alternative home for care and caregiving, at the end of their life, is now a national social crisis.
